for health care personnel in the United States

What are the updated recommendations?

Before starting a new job in a health care setting, all workers and volunteers should receive:

- TB individual risk assessment
- Symptom screening
- TB test

An annual TB test is not recommended unless there is a known exposure or ongoing transmission.

All health care personnel should receive TB education every year.

Treatment for latent TB infection (LTBI) is strongly encouraged for health care personnel diagnosed with LTBI. Shorter treatment regimens should be used.

Who is affected by the new recommendations?

Individuals who work or volunteer in health care settings

Health care settings include:

- Inpatient and outpatient settings
- Laboratories
- Emergency medical services
- Medical settings (prisons or jails)
- Home-based health care settings
- Long-term care facilities

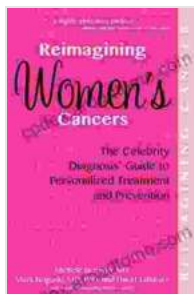

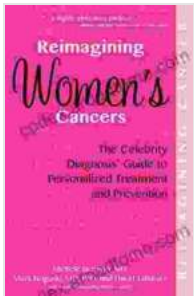

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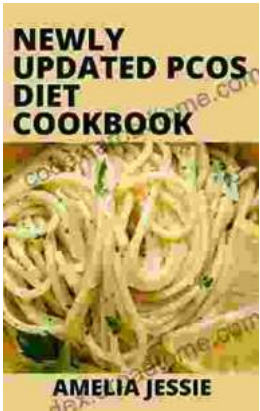
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
